

Veterans Disabled Fishing License

A reduced rate license for veterans with a service-related disability of 70% or more. The customer must show proof of this prior to purchase and the **customer must carry that documentation while using this license.**

- **Customer Catalog.** Select the “Fish” tab and choose the [Veterans Disabled Annual Fishing License](#) product



- **License add-ons.** The next screen will offer the Add-ons for Great Lakes and Inland Stamps, as well as the opportunity to purchase a Go Wild card. Make any necessary selections and then select Add To Cart.

- Go Wild Conservation Card**
Get your Card now! You will receive your card in the mail within 14 business days. The Conservation Card does not expire. It is a convenient and durable alternate to paper licenses. Licenses, stamps, and hunter education authorities can all be accessed from the Conservation Card.
- Inland Waters Trout Stamp**
Allows fishing (in addition to a license authorizing fishing) for trout on all inland waters, except Green Bay and Lake Michigan tributaries up to the first dam or lake and tributaries to Lake Superior. Conservation Patrons, Senior Citizen Recreation cardholders, and free resident Military Fishing/Small Game license holders are exempt from purchasing an inland trout stamp.
- Great Lakes Salmon/Trout Stamp**
Allows fishing (in addition to a license authorizing fishing) for trout or salmon on Lake Superior, Lake Michigan, Green Bay and the tributaries of Lake Michigan and Green Bay up to the first dam or lake. Conservation Patrons, Senior Citizen Recreation cardholders, and free resident Military Fishing/Small Game license holders are exempt from purchasing a great lakes trout & salmon stamp.

- **License Qualifications.** The next screen will explain that the customer must provide additional documentation in order to qualify for this reduced rate license. The customer must show you one of the four available **proofs of eligibility** in order to proceed. Select the one they showed you and select Continue when finished. **Note: If the customer cannot provide one of the required documents, they may not purchase this license at this time.**

- A completed Form 2500-123 "Disabled Veteran Free State Park Application" signed by a County Veteran Service Officer.
- A Wisconsin State Park & Forest Disabled Veteran or Former POW ID Card issued by the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources.
- A document from the Veterans Administration that indicates customer is receiving service-connected disability benefits due to being individually unemployable.

Note: Failure to properly verify qualifications as required by your Agent Contract could result in fines and/or termination of your authority to issue DNR licenses.
