Senior Citizen – *65 years and older	\$7	n/a
Junior fishing – **16 & 17 years old	\$7	n/a
Disabled fishing (Wisconsin residents only. Must show proof of eligibility each year)	\$7	n/a
Disabled Veteran Fishing (Wisconsin residents only. Must show VA document that show 70% service-related disability)	\$3	n/a
Armed Forces Fishing & Small Game (WI resident, active duty on furlough or leave)	FREE	n/a
2-Day Inland <u>Lake</u> Trout Fishing (includes Inland Trout Stamp)	\$14	n/a
2-Day Great Lake Fishing (Includes Great Lakes Trout & Salmon stamp)	\$14	\$14
Nonresident 4-Day Fishing	n/a	\$24
Nonresident 15-Day Fishing	n/a	\$28
Nonresident 15-day Family Fishing	n/a	\$40 Includes kids 16 & 17
Stamps – Inland Trout or Great Lakes	\$10	\$10
