

Hunter Safety Verification

Anyone born on or after January 1, 1973, must complete a State Certified Hunter Safety Education course before they can purchase a hunting license, unless they request to hunt under the mentored hunting program. There are the four most common acceptable forms of verification. **Note: A Conceal and Carry Permit is not a valid form of hunter safety certification.**

1. The customer's original, state issued, Hunter Safety Education Certificate.
