

Spring Turkey Leftover Permits

Three items are needed in order to hunt turkey: Turkey License, Turkey Stamp, and Turkey Permit (tag). Once the drawing for awarded permits is done, a date is set which begins the sale of any remaining permits at all Go Wild locations. **IMPORTANT! - Leftover spring turkey permits go on sale at a specific date and time (see the schedule below). The leftover permits will not display on your terminal until sales begin at exactly 10:00 am on that day.**

Zone 1 - March 21, 10:00 a.m. until midnight

Zone 2 - March 22, 10:00 a.m. until midnight


Zone 3 - March 23, 10:00 a.m. until midnight

Zone 4 - March 24, 10:00 a.m. until midnight


Zones 5, 6, and 7 - March 25, 10:00 a.m. until midnight

Any permits remaining for all zones – March 26, 10:00 a.m. until sold out.

1. Search for the customer and make your way to the **Customer Dashboard**. Select the **Hunt/Trap** button.



2. You will find yourself in the **Customer Catalog**. Select the **Spring Turkey Leftover Permit**. You may also find it under the Featured Products list at the top of the page.



3. Select the **Management Zone** and **Time Period** the customer asks for (zones and time periods that are sold out will appear gray and will not be selectable). **Required:** If the customer has not yet purchased their spring turkey license, the system will ask you to choose either the spring turkey license or the Conservation Patron at this time. The selected license will also include the required turkey stamp. Select the one the customer wants and Add to Cart.

Spring Turkey Leftover Permit (Resident)

Leftover harvest permit for Spring Turkey. Issued on a first come, first served basis at a rate of one per day until all zones are sold out. Select your Turkey Management Unit and Time Period. Permit holder must also have a license allowing the Spring Turkey Hunting, such as a Spring Turkey License or a Conservation Patron License.

If you have also received an awarded permit and have not picked it up, it will be automatically added to your shopping cart.

Conservation Patron ←

Allows Fishing, Small Game, Gun Deer, Archer, Crossbow, Spring and Fall Turkey licenses (permit required), special permit applications (spring/fall turkey, otter and fisher), stamp privileges (turkey, state waterfowl, pheasant, inland trout and great lakes trout & salmon). Optional privileges include Early Goose Permit and/or Exterior/Horicon Goose Permit, Hook & Line Sturgeon, and a Trapping license (if the customer qualifies).

Spring Turkey ←

License permits the hunting of wild turkey during the Spring season. Requirements for hunting include an appropriate license, a Spring Turkey Harvest Permit and a Turkey Stamp. The Turkey stamp will be automatically added to your shopping cart. The Turkey Stamp issued with your Spring Turkey License is also valid for the Fall Turkey Season.

4. Checkout, confirm payment, and have the customer sign. Make sure to confirm the zone and time period before finalizing the purchase. The **Order Receipt** page is where you will print the turkey license, stamp, and tag. **Select Customer Receipt**. A document will open and allow you to print.

5. The printed document will display the turkey license, stamp, and the tag, with zone and time period listed. Give all printed documents to the customer. These are the documents the customer will carry as their license. Note the zone and time period are correct.

Questions and answers

Q: Who can purchase a Spring Turkey leftover tag?

A: Anybody can purchase a leftover tag. Customers may purchase a leftover spring turkey tag regardless if they received one in the Spring Turkey drawing.

Q: Can a customer purchase a tag for another person?

A: A customer may only purchase a tag for themselves, or for their own minor children (under 18). Adults must be present at the agent to purchase their tag.

Q: How many tags can a customer purchase?

A: They can purchase one tag per unit per day until the requested unit is sold out.

Q: What if a customer wants to purchase other licenses along with their leftover turkey tag?

A: The leftover turkey tag will not show up on the license terminal until exactly 10:00 am. The customer is encouraged to purchase all other licenses prior to 10:00 in order to minimize the wait time for other customers.

Q: The option for a leftover tag does not show up on the screen. Why not?

A: The customer may have purchased a leftover tag that day already, or the customer may not be 10 years old yet.

Q: A customer wants a tag for zone X, time period X, but it does not show up on the terminal screen.

A: There are three possible reasons why this would happen. 1) That particular unit and/or time zone has been sold out. 2) The customer already purchased a leftover turkey tag the same day. 3) It may not be the sale date for that zone (for example, during the first week, Zone 1 goes on sale on Monday, but will not be available again until Saturday, when all zones go on sale

Q: Is the turkey stamp required to hunt turkey?

A: Yes. The customer needs one stamp per year to hunt turkey in spring and fall. They will not be charged for a turkey stamp in fall if they already purchased it in spring.

Q: What is the difference between a leftover turkey tag and an awarded turkey tag?

A: An awarded tag is a tag assigned to that customer as a result of the turkey drawing. This tag will be posted to the customer record ahead of time and will appear on the screen separate from the leftover tags. A customer may purchase a leftover tag in addition to their awarded tag.
