



Under Wisconsin law NR 8.06(1) no person may obtain hunting, trapping or fishing approval(s) for another person, with the exception of:

- A parent or guardian of a child may purchase an approval on behalf of a child under 18 years of age.
- One spouse may purchase the Wisconsin resident spousal fishing license for both spouses, even if the other spouse is not present. All customer information for both persons must be provided to the agent to complete the transaction.
- One family member can purchase the Non-Resident Family Fishing approval. All customer information must be provided to the agent to complete the transaction.

These non-license items may be purchased for another person; however all customer information must be provided to the agent to complete the transaction.

- Stamps for Inland Trout, Great Lakes Trout & Salmon, Wisconsin Waterfowl, and Pheasant.
- Permit applications to get into the drawing for turkey, bear, bobcat, fisher, otter, sharp-tailed grouse, upriver sturgeon, wolf. **THIS DOES NOT INCLUDE PURCHASING LEFT-OVER PERMITS AFTER THE DRAWING IS HELD.**
- Trail Passes – for snowmobiles and ATV/UTVs
- Renewals – for snowmobiles, ATV/UTVs, boats, Off Highway Motor Vehicles
