

# Waterfowl and Migratory Bird Hunting

*(This is a general license guide only for helping a customer choose the licenses they need for waterfowl and migratory bird hunting. The customer may have variations in their license selection, and should notify the agent before purchase. Example: Applying for Horicon Goose tags instead of Exterior goose). It is the hunter's responsibility to make sure they have all the required license approvals before hunting.*

## NOTES:

- Hunters under age 16 are exempt from state and federal waterfowl stamp requirements
- Exterior goose permit is only required for goose hunting during the regular goose season. A hunter cannot purchase both Horicon goose tags and Exterior goose tags during the same year.
- Early goose permit is only required for goose hunting during the early goose season (Sept 1 – Sept 15)
- If the customer graduated a hunter safety course this year, their hunter safety certificate doubles as their Small Game License for this year only. State Waterfowl stamp privileges are included as well. However, they must still purchase the HIP certification and they must purchase the Federal stamp if age 16 years or older.
