


Fall Turkey License

Three items are needed in order to hunt turkey: Turkey License, Turkey Stamp, and Turkey Permit (tag). Once the drawing for awarded permits is done, customers will be notified by mail that they have been awarded a turkey permit. The awarded tag will be posted in their account by DNR, and they may then purchase their turkey license and stamp.


Search for the customer and make your way to the **Customer Dashboard**. Select the **Hunt/Trap** button.



You will find yourself in the **Customer Catalog**. Select the **Awarded Fall Turkey Tag** under the Featured Products list. The price for the tag itself will show \$0, but they will be charged more for the license and stamp in a later step.

The **Awarded Fall Turkey Tag** will be automatically selected for you under Select a Tag. If the customer has not yet purchased their fall turkey license, the system will require you to choose either the fall turkey license or the Conservation Patron at this time under the **Required** section. The selected license will also include the required turkey stamp. Select the one the customer wants and Add to Cart.



The Shopping Cart will display all three items required for turkey hunting. The carcass tag for turkey is \$0, the turkey stamp is \$5.25, and the turkey license is \$15.00. Make sure to confirm the zone and time period on the tag before finalizing the purchase.

Checkout, confirm payment, and have the customer sign. The printed document will display the turkey license, stamp, and the tag, with zone and time period listed. Give all printed documents to the customer. These are the documents the customer will carry as their license. Note the zone and time period are correct.

Immediately upon killing a turkey, validate this tag by writing the date of kill and circling AM or PM. You may not leave the carcass unless this tag is attached to it. This tag must remain intact and legible. Consider protecting with a plastic bag. Registration is required by 5:00pm the day after recovery at gamereg.wi.gov or 844-426-3734. You must write the confirmation number on this tag. Retain this tag until meat is consumed.

Fall Turkey Carcass Tag: This is the tag that the hunter must carry for tagging their harvest. The tag must be validated immediately after harvest, but the tag need not be attached to the bird unless the hunter leaves the carcass.
