



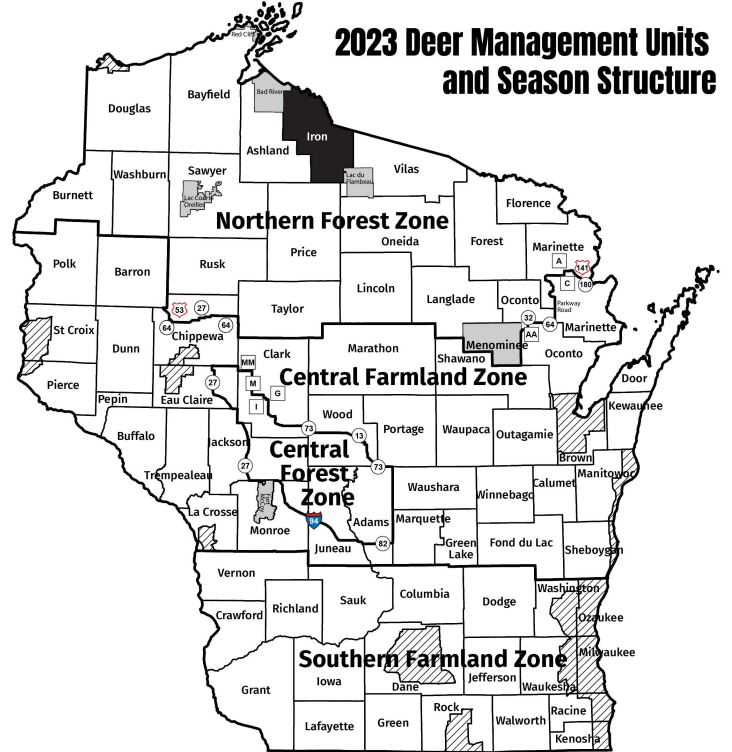
# 2023 BONUS ANTLERLESS DEER HARVEST AUTHORIZATIONS

## FIRST 3 DAYS OF SALES ARE ZONE-SPECIFIC:

- Monday, August 14 at 10 a.m. Northern and Central Forest Zones
- Tuesday, August 15 at 10 a.m. Central Farmland Zone
- Wednesday, August 16 at 10 a.m. Southern Farmland Zone
- Thursday, August 17 at 10 a.m. All Zones

**\$12 - Wisconsin resident**  
**\$20 - Non-resident**  
**\$5 - Youths age 11 and under**

- Bonus harvest authorization levels are set based on Deer Management Unit (DMU) and land type (public or private).
- Bonus harvest authorization availability will be listed online and at the license agent. If not listed, harvest authorizations are not available or sold out.
- Customer must be present to purchase bonus harvest authorizations except parents or legal guardians purchasing for children under the age of 18.
- Bonus harvest authorizations can be purchased at a rate of one per day, per person.



### 2023 Deer Season Structure

Statewide: Bucks plus antlerless by harvest authorization\*

- \*Buck only county: No antlerless harvest authorizations available for purchase Junior antlerless harvest authorizations remain valid
- ▨ Metro Sub-unit: See regulations for detailed boundaries
- Non-quota area: No harvest authorizations issued by the DNR

**You will need to answer up to three questions when you purchase a bonus harvest authorization:**

- 1) WHICH COUNTY DO YOU WANT A HARVEST AUTHORIZATION FOR?**
- 2) IF THE COUNTY HAS MORE THAN ONE ZONE TYPE (FARMLAND AND FOREST), WHICH ZONE DO YOU WANT THE HARVEST AUTHORIZATION FOR?**
- 3) IS THIS HARVEST AUTHORIZATION FOR PUBLIC\* OR PRIVATE LAND?**
