Driver's License Please

By law, every customer purchasing a license is required to show proof of identity, with the exception of parents who can vouch for the identity of their children under the age of 18. In addition, anyone purchasing a Wisconsin resident license must provide proof of residency by presenting identification. <u>A previous year's</u> <u>fishing or hunting license is not proof of</u> <u>residency!</u>

Proof of Wisconsin Residency includes:

- Valid Wisconsin driver's license (or letter of revocation or suspension); or
- Wisconsin Department of Transportation identification card; or
- Current documentation verifying name and address, which could include a WI Income Tax Return or pay stub showing WI Income Tax paid.

License agents are responsible for ensuring customers provide proper identification for proof of residency. On the GO WILD screen where the Resident and Nonresident buttons appear, we are acknowledging that we have verified the customer's current identification and address information and are attesting proper documentation was presented.
