


Nonresident Annual Family Fishing License

This license is for a nonresident family, which issues to a legally married nonresident couple or single parent and their 16 and 17 year-old children. (Customers under 16 years old do not need a fishing license, and customers 18 or over must purchase their own fishing license).


- **Adding the Secondary Customer.** Add the spouse and/or children to the license. Select the  button to add on any children who are 16 or 17 years old. You will need to enter first name, last name, and date of birth for each child. It will also offer the Add-ons for Great Lakes and/or Inland Stamps for the whole family. The box to add the **Secondary (spouse)** to the license will be checked automatically, or you may uncheck if the spouse will purchase later. Select Add To Cart.

Annual Family Fishing (Primary, Nonresident)

Allows fishing in any waters of the state. One trout or salmon stamp purchased under the primary customer covers all people on a nonresident family license. Issued to a legally married nonresident couple or single parent and their 16 and 17 year old children.

Annual Family Fishing Secondary
Allows fishing in any waters of the state. Stamp privileges are NOT required for the spouse to fish inland trout or Great Lakes trout and salmon if the primary customer has purchased the stamps. Available to the spouse of a family primary customer for no fee.

Add-on At Cost for Primary Customer

Go Wild Conservation Card
Get your Card now! You will receive your card in the mail within 14 business days. The Conservation Card does not expire. It is a convenient and durable alternate to paper licenses. Licenses, stamps, and hunter education authorities can all be accessed from the Conservation Card. You are required to carry paper carcass tags for certain species.

Inland Waters Trout Stamp
Allows fishing (in addition to a license authorizing fishing) for trout on all inland waters, except Green Bay and Lake Michigan tributaries up to the first dam or lake and tributaries to Lake Superior. Conservation Patrons, Senior Citizen Recreation cardholders, and free resident Military Fishing/Small Game license holders are exempt from purchasing an inland trout stamp.

Great Lake Salmon/Trout Stamp
Allows fishing (in addition to a license authorizing fishing) for trout or salmon on Lake Superior, Lake Michigan, Green Bay and the tributaries of Lake Michigan and Green Bay up to the first dam or lake. Conservation Patrons, Senior Citizen Recreation cardholders, and free resident Military Fishing/Small Game license holders are exempt from purchasing a great lakes trout & salmon stamp.

- Confirming the Secondary Customer.** The next screen will ask you to add the **date of birth** for the secondary customer (spouse) as well as the **DNR customer number**, **Social Security Number**, or **driver license number** to “link” the two licenses together. If the secondary customer is not present, or cannot provide the required information at this time, you can select the **Skip** button and purchase the secondary license in a separate transaction. Select Add to Cart when finished.

Annual Family Fishing (Secondary, Nonresident)

Allows fishing in any waters of the state. Stamp privileges are NOT required for the spouse to fish inland trout or Great Lakes trout and salmon if the primary customer has purchased the stamps. Available to the spouse of a family primary customer for no fee.
