Nonresident License at Resident Rates

Some nonresidents have the option to purchase certain hunting and fishing licenses at resident rates. These licenses only show up on the list of licenses for nonresident customers and are separate selections from the normal nonresident licenses. See the list of licenses below and the information the customer must provide in order to qualify to pay resident rates:

Student Licenses are sold to nonresidents who are living in the State while attending a Wisconsin University. The purchaser must show proof of a current Wisconsin University ID and they will get their license at the resident rate.

Military Licenses are sold to nonresidents members of the U.S. Armed Forces who are stationed in Wisconsin or were a Wisconsin resident when they entered the military. The purchaser must show proof of a current Military ID and they will get their license at the resident rate.
