ORDER YOUR WISCONSIN OR NONRESIDENT SNOWMOBILE TRAIL PASSES HERE!



All snowmobiles operating on a Wisconsin snowmobile trail or corridor must display a valid snowmobile trail pass whether registered in Wisconsin or another state. A trail pass is NOT required if the snowmobile has a valid Wisconsin antique registration (antique = 35 years old or greater). A trail pass is NOT required to operate on private property or on frozen water if not on a marked corridor.

Snowmobile trail passes are shipped by US Mail to the address specified. You will receive a temporary operating receipt when you place your order, which allows you to legally use your snowmobile immediately.

NONRESIDENT SNOWMOBILE TRAIL PASS - \$50

Snowmobile registered in, or in the process of being registered in another state, province or country.

*WISCONSIN SNOWMOBILE TRAIL PASS - \$30

Snowmobile must be registered in Wisconsin.

*WISCONSIN SNOWMOBILE CLUB TRAIL PASS - (Available for \$10 through the Association of Wisconsin Snowmobile Clubs only. Not available at license agents or DNR service centers) – Snowmobile must be registered in Wisconsin and owned by a person who is a member of a snowmobile club which is affiliated with the Association of Wisconsin Snowmobile Clubs (AWSC). Please visit www.awsc.org for more details. Note: Snowmobile trail pass fees are non-refundable if the snowmobile's owner purchases a full priced snowmobile trail pass and later purchases a club member pass at the discounted rate.
